- 1. The Armed Forces Rapidplay Chess Championship will take place at Sharland Hall, RAF Benson, Wallingford, Oxon, OX10 6AA on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> Nov and Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov 2025.
- 2. Prizes will be awarded for: Overall Tournament winner Highest placed <1750 Highest placed <1500

3. The competition is open to all members of the Armed Forces, Reserves, MOD Civil Service and Armed Forces Chess Association members; players of all standards are welcome. The format of the championships is an 8 round Swiss tournament played in accordance with the FIDE laws of chess. A seeded draw will determine pairings for the first round, thereafter, players will be drawn against another with the same or similar number of points. Nobody is eliminated in a Swiss tournament and players are expected to compete in all 8 rounds. Rate of play is 20 minutes per player with a 5 second increment per move.
